



Play2Gether after school club offers an opportunity for children to take part in a range of different activities after school so that parents are able to pick them up at a later time.

Play2Gether ethos is about providing a safe, healthy and happy environment in which our children are encouraged to develop a range of skills in a relaxed atmosphere. Happiness and wellbeing are at the core of our values, as we acknowledge that 'every child matters'.

The after-school club will run daily from 3:15 until 6pm.

Aims

- This provision aims to provide an affordable child care facility for parents each evening after school
- To provide a safe, welcoming and secure environment for children
- To provide a healthy, nutritious snack for pupils
- To provide a calm environment in which children have access to a range of activities.

Staffing

- All staff hold fully updated DBS and safeguarding checks.
- After school club staff have completed Emergency First Aid training, food hygiene, and safeguarding alongside other mandatory training.

Booking

- All booked sessions cost £15.00. If you choose to collect your child during the session the cost remains the same. These sessions will be booked in advance and roll over each term, parents must give terms notice for any amendments or cancellations to their committed bookings.
- A Registration visit and completion of registration forms must be completed before any sessions can be booked.
- Play2Gether do also accept ad hoc (emergency bookings) however this depends on each days availability.
- Payments and bookings must be made in advance.

- All pre-booked sessions will be charged in full via invoice. Play2gether are unable to credit or refund any sessions your child does not attend.
- Children must be collected promptly at the end of the session. We are unable to offer care after the contracted hours due to a variety of reasons.

Behaviour

- Children are aware of our Behaviour Policy and they are reminded on a regular basis of behaviour expectations.
- Children will be encouraged to use calming techniques, i.e. they may be asked to withdraw from an activity for a short period of time in order to calm down. Unacceptable behaviour is always discussed with the child in order for them to understand why their behaviour is unacceptable.
- Children's pattern of behaviour can often change when under stress. Parents should inform the Club Manager of any change of circumstances that could affect a child's behaviour. This information will be in the strictest confidence.
- It may sometimes be necessary to inform the child's parent/carer if unacceptable behaviour continues so that a joint approach can be used.
- In exceptional circumstances the offer of a place at the After School Club may be withdrawn.

Evening Snack

- The After-school Club operates a healthy menu and will provide food each day.
- Typical foods available during after school Club include Fruit bowl veggie bowl/ Drinking Water, sandwiches, wraps, pitta bread, bagels, sandwich thins, fruit bread (ham, cheese, chicken, jam, tuna, marmite, humus etc).
- Dietary needs and allergies can be catered for if we are given prior notification. All dietary requirements should be discussed with the setting manager.

Activities and Resources

- A varied range of activities can be enjoyed at After School Club. Including organised games, board games, arts and crafts activities, reading, Lego, small world, role play, messy play, sports, team games, construction, science experiments etc
